Harvey Fierstein (Book) - Harvey Fierstein is a four-time Tony Award-winning writer and actor. His Broadway writing credits include *Kinky Boots, Torch Song Trilogy* (Tony, Drama Desk, Dramatists Guild Awards), *Casa Valentina, Safe Sex, Legs Diamond*, and *A Catered Affair* (12 Drama Desk nominations and the Drama League Award for Best Musical).

His La Cage Aux Folles is the only show to ever win Best Musical and two Best Revival Tony Awards. Other plays include Spookhouse, Forget Him, and Flatbush Tosca. Other honors include the Drama League Award for Outstanding Performer of the Year, a special OBIE award, NY Magazine Award, and nominations for The Olivier Award and an Emmy. He was inducted into The Theater Hall of Fame in 2008.



Sharon FitzHenry (Director) - Sharon is so excited to be working with this dream team of Bill, Eddie, Moonyean, Nate, and Eric for *KB*! Past OHP credits include directing *Mamma Mia*!, Something Rotten!, Newsies, Parade, Titanic, Into the Woods, Spamalot, Les Misérables, next to normal, La Cage Aux Folles, Ragtime, Secret Garden, Big River,

Urinetown, and Piecemeal in past seasons. She is also a lighting designer (most recently, Hunchback for OHP) and a sometimes costumer. Other local credits include Macbeth and Sweeney Todd for Suffield Players and Inherit the Wind for Little Theatre of Manchester. Sharon is a proud member of Actors' Equity Association and an associate member of Stage Directors & Choreographers.



Cyndi Lauper (Music & Lyrics) - Cyndi Lauper is a Grammy, Emmy, and Tony Award-winning artist with over 30 sterling years and global record sales in excess of 50 million albums. With her first album, "She's So Unusual," Lauper won a Grammy Award for Best New Artist and became the first female in history to have four top-five singles from a debut

album. Since then, Lauper has released ten additional studio albums, been inducted into the Songwriters Hall of Fame and celebrated as a New York Times best-selling author. Lauper has been nominated for 15 Grammy Awards, two American Music Awards, seven American Video Awards and 18 MTV Awards. In 2013, Cyndi Lauper became the first solo woman to win Best original score for her music and lyrics for *Kinky Boots*.



Bill Martin (Music Director) - "Dr. Bill" is a retired veterinarian from the Longmeadow area. He has served as a music director in the area for many years and many of them here at the OHP, creating great shows alongside Sharon! OHP productions include *Something Rotten*!, *Parade, Titanic, Into the Woods, Spamalot, Les Misérables, next to normal,*

thank this incredible cast, creative team, band and crew. Thank you to his family and Ken for putting up with him. Enjoy the show.


WE'RE GOING TO HAVE A NEW THEATER!
